3 Admission Qualifications

1. Qualification Requirements (Both Tracks)

- A prospective applicant and his/her both parents are all foreigners.
- A person who has completed all regular curriculums corresponding to Korean or foreign elementary and secondary education and has a high school graduation (scheduled) or higher education.

2. Qualifications for First-Year and Transfer

※Those who completed the "Intermediate 1B" course at Sejong Institute / completed level 3 or higher at Kyungsung University's Korean Language Institute / completed the "undergraduate preliminary course" at Kyungsung University's Overseas Korean Language Center / passed the evaluation of Kyungsung University.

※Among the Korean Track successful students who is a holder of TOPIK level 2 or a lesser grade, he/she is required to complete at least 300 hours of the Korean training program for a year upon admission (Ministry of Education).

※The regulation of Kyungsung University foreign students graduation requirement

- English Track: Graduation possible if a student is a holder of at least one of the following English Proficiency Test scores - TOEFL iBT 71 (PBT 530, CBT 197), IELTS 5.5, CEFR B2, TEPS 600, NEW TEPS 327, TOEIC 700
- Korean Track: Graduation possible if a student is a holder of at least Test of Proficiency in Korea (TOPIK) level 4 issued by the National Institute for International Education.

B. Precautions for Admission Qualifications

- 1) As a non-Korean prospective international applicant and both parents as foreigners must meet all of the following eligibility criteria
 - The prospective applicant and his/her both parents are recognized as foreigners only if the applying student and both parents hold a foreign citizenship before the start of study in Republic of Korea.
 - In the case of a prospective applicant and his/her both parents have changed (loss of/rejected) nationality, the applying student must submit a Certificate of Loss of Nationality.
 - In the case if a parent is the only financial provider due to a divorce, death, or other reasons, one parent either the applicant's mother's or father's nationality shall only be applied; however, the reason must be identified/verified by a government-issued document.
 - A prospective applicant with multiple nationalities that include Korean nationality is not recognized as a foreigner.
- 2) The status of one's nationality standard is in accordance with the application date.
- 3) English track refers to a curriculum in which students can graduate by taking major and liberal arts courses in English, and interview screening is also conducted in English.
- 4) A prospective applicant who graduated with a domestic or foreign qualification exam such as GED, home schooling (home education, EHE), cyber learning, language institutes, and other similar means of completing education are not recognized as regular courses.
- 5) The list of the countries that uses English as its mother tongue or uses English as a legal official language are limited to the ones that only specifies the countries information at the homepage of Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Republic of Korea.
- 6) At the time of application, a prospective applicant shall submit his/her language proficiency test certification within its validity date.
- 7) The Minister of Justice notified of 21 countries: China, Philippines, Indonesia, Sri Lanka, India, Myanmar, Bangladesh, Vietnam, Mongol, Thailand, Pakistan, Nepal, Iran, Uzbekistan, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Ukraine, Nigeria, Ghana, Egypt, Peru

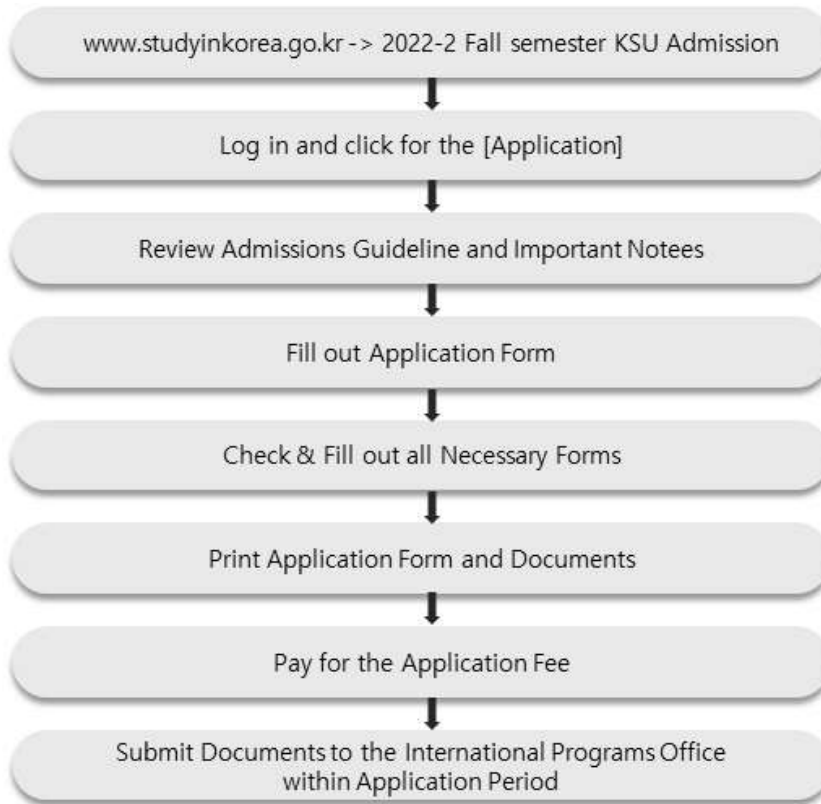
- A. Document Screening: After reviewing all submitted documents, student academic ability, language proficiency, and other qualifications shall be evaluated. (If needed, additional/missing documents may be requested.)
- B. Interview: Conducted only for qualified applicants after documents screening process
- C. Interview Method: The original method shall be face-to-face (oral) method, but in the case if the oral face-to-face (oral) method is impossible, the interview shall be completed via phone call or video call.
- D. A prospective applicant may be asked to take a practical/performance examination or additional document submission may be requested when applying to certain departments, such as the College of Art, Music, and Physical Education.
- E. Korean track applicants can conduct Korean language test during the admission process, and they must take the test (the application fee will be notified separately).

2. Application Fee

- A. Fee: 38,000 KRW or 35 USD
- B. Payment Method: Bank Account
 ※ Bank account details can be referred on school's homepage notice board (www.ks.ac.kr/eng→Undergraduate→Notice)
- C. Payment deadline: Same as Application Period
- D. Once the online application has been completed and submitted, the application cannot be cancelled and the application fee cannot be refunded.

※ NOTES – Document Submission

1. All application documents must be submitted in Korean or English, and documents written in languages other than Korean or English must accompany a complete Korean or English translation authenticated by the issuing institution or notarized by a notary public.
2. All application documents must be submitted directly to the relevant office in person or via postage/mail, and any documents that does not arrive by the application deadline shall be disqualified.
3. If needed, additional document(s) can be requested to the prospective applicant and documents shall not be returned to the student.
4. All application documents must be legible and undamaged for screening process.
5. If a prospective applicant is expected to graduate, admission is possible if he/she submits the official degree certificate (or diploma) by end of August 2022.
6. If the contents of the application documents are insufficient and not suitable for evaluation it shall be disqualified.

1. About Application

- A. If needed, additional document(s) shall be requested individually to the prospective applicant.
- B. If a prospective applicant's qualifications are deemed insufficient at a later stage, there is still a possibility of cancellation of admission.
- C. The contents that are not included in this application guideline shall be determined by Kyungsoong University relevant committee, and all matters after admission are in accordance with the school policy and regulations of Kyungsoong University.
- D. If a prospective applicant violates and applies to more than one department, he/she shall be disqualified.

2. About Online Application

- A. A prospective applicant shall be held responsible and for any consequences caused by entry errors, omitted entries, and writings inability to read.
- B. Application is strictly completed via online and it is not hand-written, except for applicant's signature(s).
- C. Applicant's name, date of birth, and other personal information on application form shall match with the information on own's passport (other submitted documents are also applied in the same way.)
- D. Once the online application is finally submitted, a prospective applicant cannot change his/her applying major nor cancel the application.
- E. Contact information such as emergency number and address shall be entered accurately in order to reach the applicant's guardian in case of an emergency, and Kyungsoong University shall not be held responsible for any incorrect information.

3. About Application/Document Submission

- A. All submitting documents must be presented in their original forms, and if a prospective applicant must submit a photocopies of documents, he/she should check with the relevant office in charge and submit it at a later date.
- B. If the submitted documents cannot be properly verified and additional document(s) is requested, and if he applicant fails to comply to submit it within the deadline, there is a cancellation/disqualification even after admission.
- C. If the applicant name is different from other official documents, a verification document shall be submitted additionally as evidence issued by court or other relevant head diplomatic affairs office.
- D. If a successful prospective applicant is expected to graduate, he/she must submit the graduation certificate and official transcript before admission, and failure to comply shall result in cancellation of admission.
- E. Submitted documents are not returned back to the student, and if any omitted information, forgery of document(s), false information, or other dishonest means is identified during the application process, there is a disqualification/cancellation regardless if it is before or after admission.
- F. If an admission required language proficiency test certification (TOPIK, IELTS, TOEFL iBT) is not submitted with the specified period, there is a possibility of cancellation of admission.
- G. Korea's Certificate of Balance shall be submitted in the case of domestic residents, and a Certificate of Balance (other Certificate of Balance is not acceptable) from the KDB Bank (Tashkent) are acceptable (a deposit at least a month) in the case of Uzbekistan.

4. About Successful Applicants

A successful applicant shall pay the school fees within the specified period.

D. Kyung Sung University Foreign Student Insurance Subscription

1) National Health Insurance: As of March 2021, foreign students are strictly scheduled to be subscribed to the National Health Insurance as a local subscriber in accordance with the policy of the Ministry of Education and students must maintain the insurance coverage during his/her study.

2) Foreign Student Insurance (Indemnity Insurance)

※Detailed information shall be informed to those successful students for admission.

E. If a prospective applicant receive a notice of acceptance by another university before the final selection announcement, he/she must immediately notify the unwanted university of the decision or situation.

F. The official Certificate of Admission is issued to the students who have successfully paid his/her school fees.

G. Among the Korean Track successful students who is a holder of TOPIK level 2 or a lesser grade, he/she is required to complete at least 300 hours of the Korean training program for a year upon admission (Ministry of Education).

※Among the successful applicants for the Korean Track and Global Korean Studies major, those who do not submit grades of Grade 3 or higher of TOPIK are required to take the "TOPIK Special Class" organized by Kyung Sung University after admission until they acquire level 3 of TOPIK for 1 year. (Except for those who have completed the course of Korean Language Center at Kyung Sung University in Korea or overseas.)

※1 semester - 130 hours (tuition fee: 360,000 won) / 2 semesters - 260 hours (tuition fee: 720,000 won)

5. About Visa Relations

- A successful applicant who has passed the whole admission process but visa is disapproved or entry into the country is denied, the University does not guarantee the issuance of a visa to the student.

- If a student does not enter the country before the semester start date or within a designated period, admission may be cancelled.

6. Requirements for graduation

- English Track: Acquired one or more of TOEFL iBT 71 (PBT 530, CBT 197), IELTS 5.5, CEFR B2, TEPS 600, NEW TEPS 327, and TOEIC 700 or more.

- Korean Track: Acquisition of Level 4 or higher in the Korean Language Proficiency Test (hereinafter referred to as "TOPK") conducted by the National Institute of International Education.

- If the above conditions are not met, then a student is not eligible to graduate based on the regulation of Kyung Sung University foreign students graduation requirement.

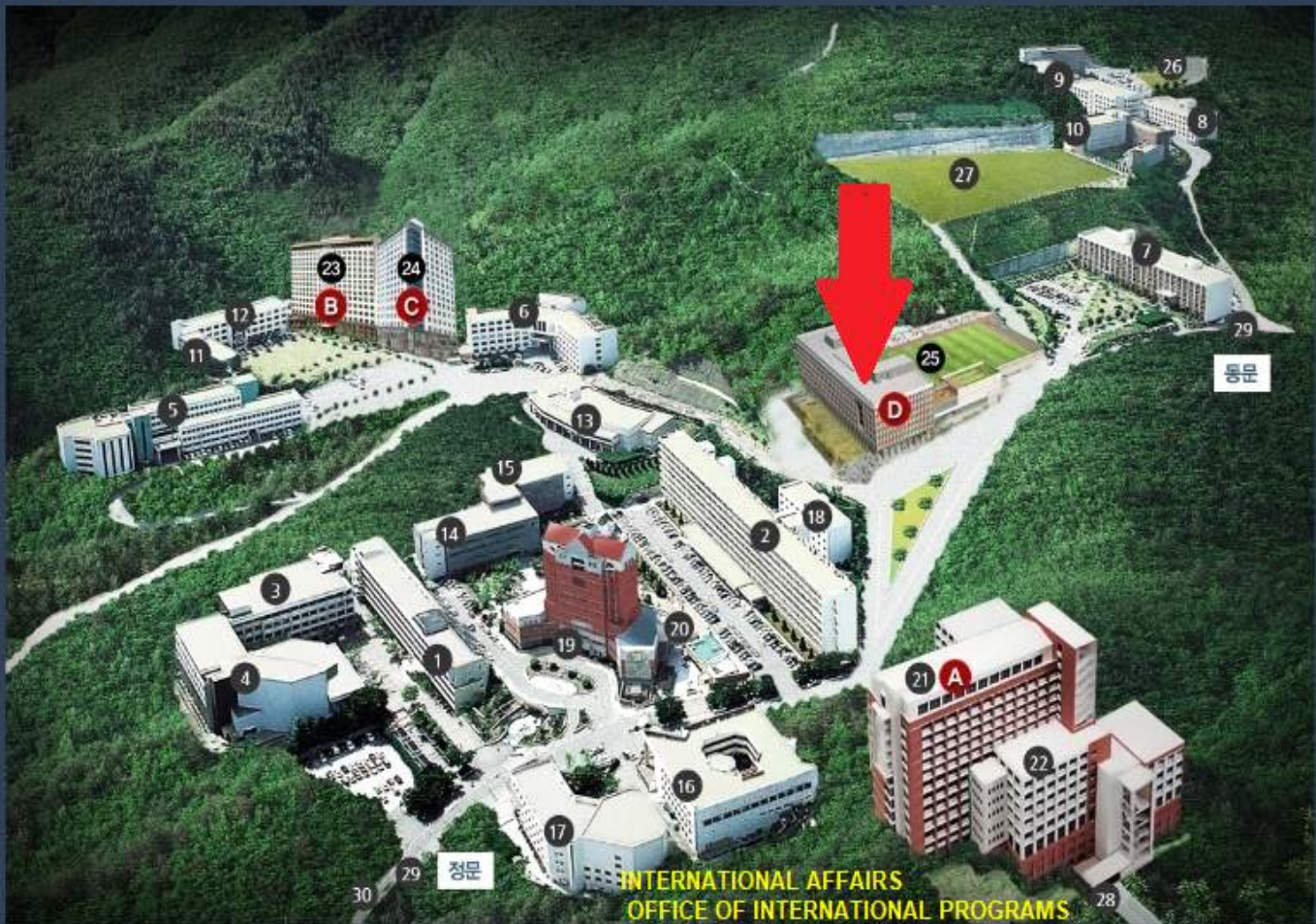
